Those Leaving the Danzig Flemish Mennonite Church: 1802-1806

Church transfers are a very important source of genealogical information. They allow one to follow a person from one location, or congregation, to another. The transferring person was usually expected to present an *Attest* (a transfer certificate) upon transferring to a new congregation. Unfortunately, very few records of transfer, and almost no *Attesten*, have survived.

The following is a list of the only transfer records available for the Danzig Flemish Mennonite congregation, and only for those transferring out.

Apr 1804	Abraham Neudorf jun. without Attest to the Reformed church.
Jul 1804	Cornelius Zimmermann jun. without Attest to another religion.
Jul 1804	Claas Hiebert of Holm, wife and children without Attest to Russia.
Nov 1804	Anton Busenitz without attest to another religion.
23 Aug 1804	Cornelius Epp, minister of the Landgemeinde to Russia.
23 Aug 1804	Claas Reimer minister of the Landgemeinde to Russia.
23 Aug 1804	Franz Wiens, son of Gil. [Julius] Wiens, to Russia as a servant.
23 Aug 1804	Johann Regier with wife and children to Russia
23 Aug 1804	Maria Thielmann, dau. of Jac. Thielmann to Russia as a servant.
23 Aug 1804	Peter Classen sen. Of Hochzeit with wife and children to Russia.
23 Aug 1804	Peter Classen jun. and wife Gertrud Regier, to Russia.
23 Aug 1804	her (Gert. Regier) sister Agnetha Regier, dau. of Mich. Regier, to Russia.
23 Aug 1804	Cornelius Woelke and wife and children to Russia.
21 May 1805	Anna Janzen, dau. of Bernh. Janzen, to Elbing with Attest.
5 Jan 1805	Sara Fast, dau. of Fr[iedrich] Fast of Krampitz with Attest to the Neugarten [Frisian] church.
29 Sep 1805	David Dyck, with birth and baptism certificate to another religion.
Aug 1805	Catharina Thielmann, with birth and baptism certificate to another religion.
Oct 1805	Catharina Liessau, without Attest to another religion.
Oct 1805	Widow Bernhard Janzen and son Bernhard to Elbing, without Attest.
11 Aug 1805	Anna Toews recently married a Reimer in St. Albrecht [no destination?].

1805	Jacob Zacharias, wife and son to another religion.
12 Dec 1805	Abraham Momber, son of Is. Momber with Attest to the Neugarten [Frisian] church.
10 Aug 1806	Abraham Thiessen, son of Joh. Thiessen, with Attest to the [Frisian] Orlof[ferfelde Frisian] church.
10 Aug 1806	Maria Wiebe, dau. of Franz W of Plenendorf, without Attest to the Lutheran religion.
30 Sep 1806	Paul Zacharias, son of Paul Z. an Attest sent to the Friedrichsstadt church.
26 Oct 1806	Abraham & Berend Kauenhofen, son of Abr. K. took Attests on trip [where?].
Jun 1806	Susanna Wiens, dau. of Gerh. W. without Attest to the Lutheran religion.
1806	Johann Schroeder, son of Herm. S. without Attest to the Lutheran religion.
