Many of these families can also be found in the book “Mennonite Migrations” by Peter Rempel. This table, however, is not found in that book.

A: Family number.

B: Name of the Mennonite.

C: Number of people (M = males, F = females, T = total).

D: Year of entry.

E: Furniture value in rubles (Rub) and Kopeks (Kop).

F: Possessions brought along: W = wagons, H = horses and C = cattle. Value in Rubles (Rub) and Kopecs (Kop).

G: Cash brought along.

H: Total value of possessions and cash.

I: Grants paid by the Commission.

J: For the purchase of wagons, horses, and cattle.

K: For house building and economic purchases.

L: Total grants granted.
