

# The First Mennonite Settlers in the Chortitza Settlement

**Part 1: The Original 228 Families Settling in Chortitza: 1789-90**

**Part 2: The 57 Families that Arrived in Chortitza  
between 1793 and 1795**

The title of this document is “Account of how much out of 18,891 rubles 91 ¼ kopeikas sent to the Khortitskaya colony shall be given to each of the Mennonite families that departed with the first and the last groups.” Although the date of this list is given as 26 January 1800, it is obvious upon further investigation that the first part of the list must have been made in 1789 or 1790. Wilhelm Kampen, who is known from reliable sources to have died on 23 Apr 1789, is not on the list. His son Jacob is the only Kampen on the list. Wilhelm Bollee, who died on 31 May 1789, is on the list. Widower Peter Klassen is on list – he died on 6 Mar 1789. This would indicate that the list was made in April or May 1789. One problem with this is the inclusion of those who are known to have arrived in Chortitza in the spring of 1790. One such family was that of David Epp (#29 on the list). It looks like this list contains those 228 families who actually arrived at the Chortitza colony site, whether in 1789 or the spring of 1790. These are the 228 families who established the Chortitza colony in 1790. To my knowledge, there were no arrivals in 1791 or 1792. Between 1793 and 1795, 57 additional families also settled in the Chortitza settlement.

The following is a conversion of the above information into tables with added information.

Guide to the spreadsheet:

The 1<sup>st</sup> column is the numbering as it appears in the original.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> column gives the standardized surname.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> column gives the standardized first name.

The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> columns give the number of adults “Ad” and Children “Ch”. It is not known what the cut-off age is for this list. There are 599 adults and 398 children, for a total of 997.

The 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> columns indicate how much money was given to each family. Adults received 5 Rubles and 3 Kopeks while children received one-half that.

The 8<sup>th</sup> column indicates which village the family originally settled.

The 9<sup>th</sup> column contains the number of the household head in the GRANDMA database. For more information on GM see: <https://www.grandmaonline.org/gmolstore/pc/Overview-d1.htm> .

The last (10<sup>th</sup>) column has birth and/or death years based mostly on ages in early Chortitza census records, family records and some Prussian church records, as found in the GRANDMA database. Many of these household heads are not found in the [complete listing of household heads for 1793](#). Even more are not found in the [1795 census of the Chortitza colony](#). Note that 60 of the 228 household heads are not found in the 1795 census; that's about *one in four* of ALL household heads! Only one family in this list is known to have returned to Prussia. The only conclusion I can come up with is that most of these 60 men died between 1788 and 1795. In many cases it can be shown that the widows of these men remarried during that time period. See the GRANDMA database for more information.

Light green highlighting indicates that this person could be interchanged with another of the same name. For example, there are 4 Peter Dycks in the list!

Yellow highlighting indicates that there is some sort of problem, such as uncertainty as to who the person is and/or in assigning a GM number. Since the only solid information we have from this list is the name of the head of the household, the assignments of GM numbers for many people is tentative and may change as more information becomes available. It is difficult to use the counts of adults and children since we do not know the cut-off age used by the Russian authorities. Note that the death rate during this immigration process was exceptionally high, making the comparison of this count with other records very difficult.

## Part 2: The 57 Families that Arrived in Chortitza between 1793 and 1795

This list is incomplete in that it does not include those families who arrived in 1793 and founded the village of Kronsgarten. The columns for the spreadsheet are as follows:

The 1<sup>st</sup> column is the numbering as it appears in the original.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> column gives the standardized surname.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> column gives the standardized first name.

The 4<sup>th</sup> column is a total count of the family members. The total number counted is 323 persons.

The 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> columns contain the amount given “per person” in Rubels and Kopeks.

The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> columns contain the total amount given to each family.

The 9<sup>th</sup> column has the year in immigration

The 10<sup>th</sup> column gives the transport number: there were a total of 8 transports, presumably from Dubrovna to Chortitza, in this list.

The 11<sup>th</sup> column contains the number of the household head in the GRANDMA database. For more information on GM see: <https://www.grandmaonline.org/gmolstore/pc/Overview-d1.htm> .

The last (12<sup>th</sup>) column has birth and/or death years based mostly on ages in early Chortitza census records, family records and some Prussian church records, as found in the GRANDMA database.

Yellow highlighting indicates that there is some sort of problem such as uncertainty who the person is and/or in assigning a GM number. Since the only solid information we have from this list is the name of the head of the household, the assignments of GM numbers for many people is tentative and may change as more information becomes available.
