Request to have a Mennonite Brethren (Brudergemeinde) Conference in Rueckenau, Molotschna: 1912

In 1912 a group of congregations, including the Siberian Allgemeine Bundeskonferenz congregation and 14 Mennonite Brethren (Brudergemeinde) congregations requested permission to organize a conference in Rueckenau, Molotschna colony. The following is a translation of that request, together with the names of all members who signed the request.

It is of interest to see that the majority of signatories signed their names in Russian cyrillic, as opposed to the usual German gothic script.

1) Siberia, Barnaul I [Allgemeine Bundeskonferenz]

Certificate

on the establishment of a Mennonite ecclesial association for the Orlov Rayon, Wolost Barnaul, Tomsk Governorate.

On November 25, 1911, we, Mennonites, who settled on the state lands in the Orlov District, Wolost Barnaul, Tomsk Governorate, were summoned by the elder *Jacob Gerbrandt* to a brotherhood meeting. The elder was commissioned by the meeting of the elders of the Mennonite communities in southern Russia. The brotherhood Assembly decided to form a new association from the ranks of the Mennonite congregations of the 5 parishes: Orlov, Reinfeld, Grünfeld, Kleefeld and Markowski and give it the name "Church Mennonite Association Orlov".

In accordance with our rules, we have chosen the following preachers from our ranks:

from the congregation of Orlov: Peter Wiebe, Gerhard Wiebe, Abraham Neufeld, Isaac Friesen, Abraham Toews and Kornelius Dyck.

from the congregation of Reinnfeld: Franz Buller, Johann Bergmann, Gerhard Voth, Gerhard Friesen and Peter Ens.

from the congregation of Grünfeld: *Peter* and Dietrich *Epp*.

from the congregation of Kleefeld: Kornelius Wiens, Jacob Voth, Peter Enbrecht and Abraham Dyck.

from the congregation of Markowski: Jacob Enns, Franz Derksen, Peter Enns, David Becker, Peter Harder and Abraham Klassen.

These persons have proved with deed and word their Christian character and have the necessary knowledge of the Christian faith and abilities to admonish.

The elder preacher *Peter Jacob Wiebe* was commissioned by us to keep the registers, who is to carry out this task in accordance with the applicable laws.

Our organization is based on the general decision of the Mennonites and we invoke Articles 1104-1105 of the Statute on the Spiritual Activity of Foreign Faith Denominations and the Supreme Rescript of Emperor Paul I, of October 6, 1800. In the above-mentioned rescript it says in point 1: "Hereby we confirm to their descendants the promised free and unhindered exercise of their faith, in accordance with their laws and traditions".


