Diedrich Benjamin Schultz (1846-1908; GM#266858) was the founder of the "Firma D. B. Schulz u. Erben." The factory started with the manufacturing of winnowing machines and then to every type of agricultural machine in the Ukraine\*. This file was constructed from the ledger of the Schultz factory in Osterwick, Chortitza Colony. The religion of each person is recorded. This made it relatively easy to identify the Mennonite employees. All employees were male. The patronymic for each employee is give as well as their ages. This aided the identification of individuals in the GRANDMA database.
