## **Molotschna Settlement Property Transfers: 1847**

## State Archives of the Odessa Region, Odessa, Ukraine Fond 6 Inventory 2 File 9547

The following property transfers are for the 1st half of the year 1847. I have provided summaries in English of the German table, which removes the German bureaucratese and extraneous information. The 8th census (Revision List) mentioned in the 4th column refers to the 1835 Molotschna Settlement census. This has survived and information therein has been added to the <u>GRANDMA</u> genealogical database.

The last column is based on the translation of the accompanying Russian documents by Nikolai Mazharenko.

Note that the property numbers (as referred to in column 1 may not always coincide with the family numbers used in the Revision Lists (censuses).

The Russian version gives ages in the 1835 census as 53 for Peter Fast, 28 for son Peter, 25 for son Bernhard and 21 for son Johann. Sons Bernhard and Johann both work as teachers.

9	Altona	Heinrich <b>Epp</b> has died and his heirs wish to sell the Wirtschaft. The two oldest sons, Johann and Cornelius already have their own Wirtschaften and the two youngest, Peter and Gerhard, are under age and do not have the capital.	Dirk <b>Friesen</b> of Muensterberg who was recorded in the household of his father Julius <b>Friesen</b> at #12 Muensterberg in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft. According to the Russian version Cornelius Friesen was 13 years old in the 1835 census
3	Tiegerweide	Jacob <b>Kroeker</b> has died and his heir wishes to sell.	Cornelius <b>Klassen</b> of Tiegerweide who was recorded in the household of his father Jacob <b>Klassen</b> at #22 Tiegerweide in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version implies that Jacob Kroeker was still alive.
3	Neukirch	Gerhard <b>Ens</b> wishes to sell as he is moving to the Hebrew settlement in Cherson.	Jacob <b>Braun</b> of Lindenau who was recorded in the household of his father Isaac <b>Braun</b> at #26 Lindenau in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that in the 1835 census Jacob Braun was 16 years old and 2 brothers.

6	Elisabeththal	The widow of Peter <b>Dyck</b> wishes to sell the Wirtscaft since her only son Peter already has a Wirtschaft.	Heinrich <b>Epp</b> of Elisabeththal who was recorded in the household of his father Heinrich <b>Epp</b> at #3 Elisabeththal in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that in the 1835 census Peter Dyck was 57 years old and son Peter was 22. Heinrich Epp was 14, with 4 brothers.
16	Franzthal	Cornelius <b>Siemens</b> is 67 years old, ailing and poor. His only son does not have the resources to take over.	Andreas <b>Pankratz</b> of Gnadenfeld. Immigrated since the 8th census and was added to Gnadenfeld #2 under his [unnamed] father on 8 May 1836.	Russian version states that in 1835 Siemens was 51 and son Cornelius was 19. He (presumably Corn. Jr.) wants to be a teacher. Also that Pankratz was the 19 year old, 3rd son of Jacob Pankratz, who had a total of 10 children in 1835.
3	Grossweide	Solomon <b>Ediger</b> has died and his heirs wish to sell the Wirtschaft. His various sons already posses Wirtschaften of their own.	Aron <b>Sudermann</b> of Pastwa who was recorded in the household of his father Dirk <b>Sudermann</b> at #13 Pastwa in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	According to the Russian version Aron Suderman was 13 years old in the 1835 census and had two brothers.
11	Sparrau	Heinrich <b>Dyck</b> wishes to sell his Wirtschaft as he is aged, a widower and chldless.	Peter <b>Harms</b> of Blumstein who was recorded at #12 Blumstein in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that in 1835 Heinrich Dyck was 33 and Peter harms was 28.

2	Sparrau	Wilhelm <b>Ewert</b> wishes to sell his Wirtschaft due to poor health. The property is appraised at 714 Rubel and 28 1/2 Kopec (Silver).	Franz <b>Klassen</b> of Blumenort who was recorded at #1 Blumenort in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	
3	Fuerstenwerder	Heinrich <b>Willms</b> had died and the guardians of his underage children wish to sell the Wirtschaft.	Claas <b>Reimer</b> of Ohrloff who was recorded in the household of his father Claas <b>Reimer</b> at #16 [Ohrloff] in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that in the 1835 census Claas Reimer was 21 years old and had 4 brothers.
1	Liebenau	Franz <b>Klassen</b> , who is aged and has been ill for some time, wishes to sell his Wirtschaft	Abraham <b>Reimer</b> of Halbstadt who was recorded in the household of his father Isaac <b>Reimer</b> at #25 Halbstadt in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that at this time Franz Klassen does have sons. According to the 1835 census he was 22 years old and his brothers were younger.

10	Schoensee	Jann [Johann] Gossen, who is elderly wishes to sell his Wirtschaft. His oldest son Johann has obtained his own Wirtschaft through marriage and the youngest son, Heinrich, does not have the capital.	Johann <b>Goertzen</b> of Fuerstenwerder who was recorded in the household of his father Heinrich <b>Goertz</b> at #13 Fuerstenwerder in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	There is some confusion here. #10 was owned by Dirk Bolt in 1835 and that property was owned by Joh. Goertzen by the time of the 1847 voters list. The only property owned by Johann Gossen in 1835 was #7 and that property went to Peter Wiens sometime before the 1847 voters list. It is possible that Gossen and Bolt exchanged properties between 1835 and 1847.
4	Ladekopp	The heirs of the late Jacob Warkentin wish to sell the Wirtschaft. The oldest son, Johann has a Wirtschaft in Rosenort and the other two sons are unmarried and do not have the capital.	David <b>Walde</b> of Blumenort who was recorded in the household of his father Dirk <b>Walde</b> at #4 Blumenort in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that in the 1835 census Jacob Warkentin's sons were Johann 17; Jacob 13; and David 9. David Walde was 15 and had 2 brothers.

28	Conteniusfeld	Johann <b>Funk</b> , due to poor health, wishes to sell his Wirtschaft.	Andreas <b>Voth</b> of Friedensdorf, who was recorded in the household of his brother Benjamin <b>Voth</b> at #24 Friedensdorf. in the 8th census. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that Johann Funk does not have any children.
17	Waldheim	Benjamin <b>Unruh</b> has moved to the Hebrew settlement in Ekaterinoslav Province and wishes to sell his Wirtschaft.	Johann <b>Penner</b> of Rueckenau, who was added to family #1 Rueckenau on 23 Feb 1844. Has not previously owned a Wirtschaft.	Russian version states that Johann Penner already has his own Wirthschaft.
