#### Neukirch, Molotschna Landowners: 1904

On page 5 of the October 5, 1904 Mennonitische Rundschau, M. (Martin) Huebert (GM#409266) goes through the properties in Neukirch, Molotschna colony and names owners, past and present. My comments are in square brackets.

Huebert's format follows a pattern of three names for each farm (in a few cases only two); the second name is usually followed by "früher" (earlier) and third name is followed by "später" (later). The name preceding früher appears to be the earliest owner Huebert can recall. Many of those listed below can be identified in the 1835-1862 Molotschna colony voters lists.

I have not included numbers in the GRANDMA database since there is only enough information in this list to positively identify a few people listed below.
