Nikolaipol (Nikolaifeld), Borissovo: Residents List, ca 1901

On January 23, 1901, Franz Doerksen (#174067) of Nikolaipol, Borissovo Mennonite Settlement, wrote a charming letter for *Die Mennonitische Rundschau* in which he lists the village's residents, most of whom stemmed from the Old Colony. The narrative emulates a real walk, naming the families in the order in which their homes were situated on the street (which, incidentally, ran from southeast to northwest). Nearly 100 people are mentioned.

Data extracted includes residents' names (including augmented information if I was able to locate such on GRanDMA Online), villages of origin, residence descriptions, and other pertinent notes about family, occupations, and more. All notes in square brackets are my own.
