Register of Mennonite foreign colonists who settled in Rovno (Rivnenska) Region, Volhynia, on grounds owned by the town of Wegtzin in the estate of the landowner Waclav Borejko (Watzav Warike), with the record of: the religious background of the Mennonites; the number of people, both male and female, if they have signed a contract with the landowner; the amount they pay for the rent to the landowner and the amount of taxes they pay to the government fund. The file was compiled around 1819.

First and last names of newly arrived Mennonites in the town of Wegtzin. These Mennonites left the Kingdom of Prussia in the year 1819 and in the same year arrived in Wegtzin where they will spend the up-coming winter.
